



Insects for protein

Insects are the world's most abundant creatures. Certain varieties are also the most efficient of all protein sources at converting their feed and water inputs into useable, consumable protein. Edible portions of these insects provide an even higher rate of protein than traditional sources.



Seaweed as food & fuel

Seaweed is a versatile food and bioprocessing ingredient. Already a key ingredient in thickeners and gelling agents, some varieties can be processed into environmentally-friendly 'bioplastics', fertilisers, or even fuel sources for energy production or combustion.



Insects as stock feed

Insects are an excellent feed source for animals. The larvae of the black soldier fly can quickly convert organic waste (that has little other application) into body mass suitable for processing into fish food or other agricultural feed. These products have high nutritional value.
